The Library reserves the right to keep or dispose of gift materials at the discretion of the librarian in charge. Gift materials not kept for inclusion in the collection will be disposed of by sale, exchange, donation, or discard. Receipts are provided on request. The library does not appraise or place value on materials received as donations.

The Library will accept:

- Books in good condition (no water damage, mildew, underlining or highlighting).
- Paperback books with covers intact.
- Textbooks no more than eight years old.
- Encyclopedias in complete sets and published within the last 3 years.
- DVDs, CDs, books on CD
- No more than 2 boxes or bags at one time.

The Library will not accept:

- Record albums, audiocassettes, videotapes
- Home recorded audio or videotapes
- Condensed books
- Magazines
- Materials to be recycled
